



Hotel Splendid (Paperback)

These three short novels are the first works to appear in English by a remarkable contemporary French author, Marie Redonnet. Born in Paris in 1947, Redonnet taught for a number of years in a suburban lycee before deciding to pursue a writing career full time. Since her volume of poetry *Le Mort Cie* appeared in 1985, she has published four novels, a novella, numerous short stories, and three dramatic works. In translator Jordan Stump's words, these three novels, unmistakably fit together, although they have neither characters nor setting in common. Redonnet sees the three novels as a triptych: each panel stands alone, and yet all coalesce to form a whole. Each is narrated by a different woman. *Hotel Splendid* recounts the daily life of three sisters who live in a decrepit hotel on the edge of a swamp; *Forever Valley* is about a sixteen-year-old girl who works in a dance-hall and looks for the dead; *Rose Mellie Rose* is the story of another adolescent girl who assembles a photographic and written record of her life in the dying...
