

Instead of the present method of conferring the degree of Doctor of Medicine, Dr. Smith proposes to devolve that power upon a Medical Council, as in England. However plausible this may seem, it involves nothing short of the overthrow of every institution and School of Medicine, the tenets of which are not acceptable to the American Medical...
